SureFlap multi-format microchip operated cat flap short-listed for award

There has been popular demand for SureFlap – the first multi-format microchip cat flap – following its French début at the Pet Care Product Showcase, hosted by the British Embassy in Paris earlier this year. The ingenious product has attracted a growing list of French retail customers and a new French language telephone customer service is to be launched to support them. These contributions to cross border trade have led to SureFlap being short-listed for the innovation category of the prestigious Franco British Business Awards.

Microchipping is designed to help reunite lost pets with their owners, but Cambridge physicist Dr Nick Hill saw the potential to use this unique identifier within a cat flap that only opens for a specified animal.

SureFlap has been developed using Dr Hill's sophisticated OnTune™ technology which recognises all the commonly used microchip formats that are used to identify pets throughout Europe. SureFlap has seen strong sales in key European markets including France, Germany and the Netherlands.

The French market has been particularly receptive to the new product, which has a clean, sleek design. Online retailer Vanessa Drew-Fugler of www.kitty-co.com explains,
